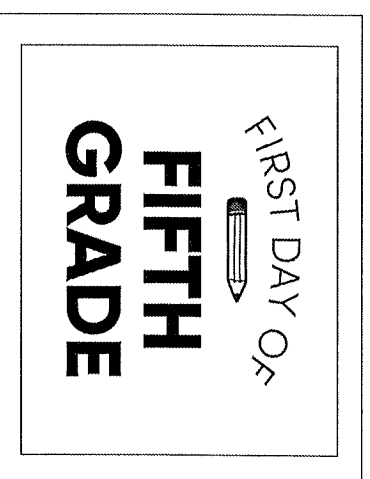


5th Grade School Supply List for 2026-2027:
