<u>Public update of Board action taken at the regular board</u> meeting, March 20, 2023:

The Board took action on the following cost saving measures at the meeting on March 20, 2023.

- 1. Approve an updated fees list that will account for consumables currently being used in classrooms and courses but not being charged back to the students. Projected cost savings of a minimum \$50,000/year
- 2. Approved a resolution to move transportation to state minimum requirements; no transportation in a 2 mile radius of the building and no transportation for grades 9-12. Also approved no transportation for extracurricular activities. Projected cost savings of a minimum \$200,000 year one.
- 3. Approved an increase in activities fees to \$250/person/sport to a family cap of \$600. Projected cost savings of a minimum \$10,000/year.

The Board also took action on open enrollment for the 2023-24 school year. The district will participate in open enrollment to the extent that they will continue to serve those students who are currently open enrolled for the 2022-23 school year but will not be accepting any new open enrollment students for the 2023-24 school year.

The Board also took action on the cost of the school breakfast. School breakfast prices will be going up \$0.25 from \$1.75 to \$2.00 due to the increasing costs of food to run the program.

**As a follow up to Board action taken previously to the March 20, 2023 meeting, the Board adopted a Chromebook Insurance cost of \$20.00 per student if they wish to take the device out of the buildings for home use. This cost will pertain only to grades 5-12. The elementary school will not have an option to send their devices home with students at this time. A copy of this insurance agreement will be available in final forms. The projected cost savings to the district will be approximately \$15,000 based on past repair details.
